

ORDINANCE NO. 424

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF DALE, COUNTY OF CAMBRIA AND STATE OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, BOROUGH OF DALE, PART 12, ARTICLE C, CHAPTER 3, BY ADDING A NEW SECTION THERETO, MAKING IT UNLAWFUL TO SHOVEL, THROW, PUSH, PLOW OR DEPOSIT OR CAUSE TO BE SHOVELED, THROWN, PUSHED, PLOWED OR DEPOSITED ONTO STREETS, ALLEYS, PLACES OR PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY WITHIN THE SAID BOROUGH, SNOW AND ICE AND ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Dale, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the corporate authority of same as follows:

SECTION 1. That Part 12, Chapter 3, Article C of the Code of Ordinances, Borough of Dale, be and the same is hereby amended by adding a new Section 12-3002, which shall read as follows:

"Section 12-3002. It shall be unlawful for any person to shovel, throw, push, plow or deposit or cause to be thrown, shoveled, pushed, plowed or deposited; snow and ice onto the streets, alleys, places and rights of ways within and maintained by the Borough of Dale. Any person violating the provisions hereof shall be guilty of an offense and shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine not less than Twenty-Five (\$25.00) Dollars nor more than Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars, plus costs of prosecution or in lieu thereof, to undergo imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than five (5) days. Further, any person violating this section shall be responsible for the cost and expense of the removal of snow and ice from the said public streets, alleys, places or rights of ways by the Borough of Dale."
